00632077-00CL) is to be adjourned to December 16, 2019 (such applications, the "Separate Receivership Applications").

- 3. Any motion for variance of the Mareva Order (capitalized terms used herein but not otherwise defined having the meaning attributed to them in the Fifth Erport of the Monitor dated November 26, 2019) by any mortgagees of property over which the Maerva Order applies shall be returnable on December 16, 2019 (such motions, "Mareva Motions").
- 4. Pending the return of the motions described above, the following shall occur:
  - by December 9, 2019, the Receiver shall provide to each of Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce, Meridian Credit Union, Laurentian Bank of Canada and FirstOntario Credit Union: (a) a proposed cost allocation as among the Retail Gas Stations (as such term is defined in the Fifth Report of the Receiver dated November 26, 2019); and (b) information regarding other relevant issues;
  - (b) any Maerva Motion shall be brought, and the moving party's materials shall be served, on or before December 9, 2019;
  - (c) any party wishing to respond to the Sale and Collection Motion or the Separate Receivership Applications shall respond to such Sale and Collection Motion or the Separate Receivership Applications, as applicable, on or before December 9, 2019;
  - (d) one of more of Simranjit Dhillon, Mandhir Dhillon, Sarbjit Dhillon and Mandeep

    Dhillon shall have provided a proposal in respect of the accounts receivable collections process by December 6, 2019; and

(e) the motion for the Interim Distribution Order shall be adjourned to a date to be determined.
