- (a) approving the second Report of the Receiver dated December 3, 2014 (the “**Report**”) and approving the activities described therein;
- (b) approving the fees and disbursements of the Receiver and its counsel, respectively, as set out in the Report; and
- (c) authorizing the Receiver to collect, settle and compromise (if the Receiver deems that to be appropriate) monies and accounts owing by account debtors to Bravo in respect of which certain creditors may claim to have an entitlement as beneficiaries of a trust, actual or deemed, whether established by contract, agreement, custom or statute (federal and provincial); and

- (d) authorizing the Receiver to examine under oath any person reasonably thought to have knowledge of the affairs of Bravo, respecting Bravo or Bravo's dealings or property;

ON READING the Report of the Receiver and the exhibits thereto and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Receiver, and such other counsel as may be present, and upon reading the affidavits of service of Nada Hannouch sworn December 18, 2014, Sepideh Nassabi sworn December 23, 2014 and Karen Fox sworn December 23, 2014,

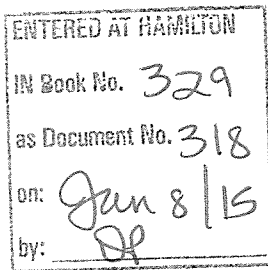
1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for serving and filing the Notice of Motion and Motion Record herein be and is hereby abridged and validated so that the motion is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof;
2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Report and the activities referred to therein be and the same are hereby approved;
3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the fees and disbursements of the Receiver and its counsel set out in the Report and the fee affidavits filed with the Court be and the same are hereby approved;
4. **THE COURT ORDERS** that the Receiver be and is hereby authorized to collect, settle and compromise (if the Receiver deems that to be appropriate) monies and accounts owing by account debtors to Bravo, including in respect of which certain creditors may claim to have an entitlement as beneficiaries of a trust, actual or deemed, whether established by contract, agreement, custom, or statute (federal and provincial), against the property of Bravo or monies received from such account debtors;

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Receiver be and is hereby authorized to examine under oath before an authorized person, any person reasonably thought to have knowledge of the affairs of Bravo, respecting Bravo or Bravo's dealings or property and specifically to determine what, if any, monies are owed to Bravo and payable to the Receiver and any person liable to be so examined shall produce any books, documents, correspondence or papers in that person's possession or power relating in all or part to Bravo or Bravo's dealings or property;

6. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Receiver may apply to this Court for advice and directions in connection with the discharge or variation of its powers and duties under this Order.
