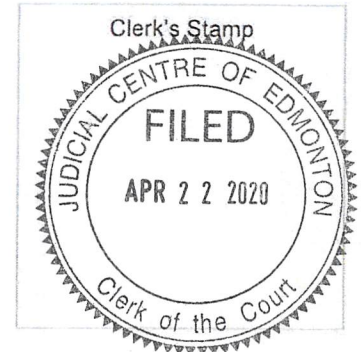


UPON noting the directives regarding emergency and urgent matters as set out in Court of Queen's Bench Master Order #2 dated March 20, 2020;

AND UPON reading the request of the Applicant for an emergency hearing and such other material as directed by the Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The request for an emergency/urgent hearing is granted.
2. The matter will be heard by telephone conference on April 28, 2020, at 3:00 p.m. at the Court of Queen's Bench Edmonton Judicial Centre.
3. A copy of this Order, the Applicant's request for an emergency hearing, and the Applicant's filed Notice of Application and Affidavit shall be served upon the Respondent by Email on or before 4:00 p.m. on April 23, 2020.
4. The Respondent shall file their response Affidavit by April 24, 2020.
