

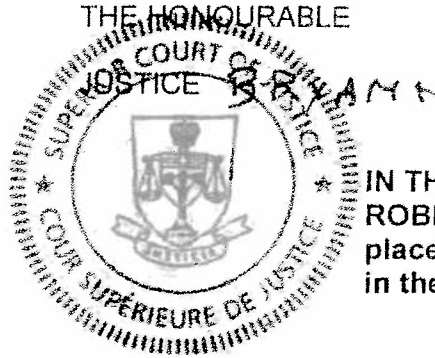

**BANKRUPTCY ORDER**

Upon the Application of Bank of Montreal, a creditor, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario, filed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012;


And upon reading the Application, the affidavit of truth of Antoniette Vita sworn July 13, 2012, the Affidavit of Antoniette Vita sworn October 12, 2012, the Consent of Robica-Forman Tank Ltd., filed, the Amended Order of Rady J. dated July 17, 2012 and the Order of Rady J. dated October 15, 2012 and upon hearing counsel for the Applicant creditor, and it appearing to the Court that the following act of bankruptcy has been committed by Robica-Forman Tank Ltd., namely:

That it has ceased to meet its liabilities generally as they have become due.

1. IT IS ORDERED that Robica-Forman Tank Ltd. of the City of St. Mary's be and it is hereby adjudged bankrupt and a Bankruptcy Order is hereby made against Robica-Forman Tank Ltd.
2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that BDO Canada Limited, of the City of Kitchener, in the Province of Ontario, is appointed as Trustee of the estate of the bankrupt.

3. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Trustee shall forthwith give security in cash or by bond in accordance with Section 16(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.

4. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the costs of the Applicant creditor be paid on a solicitor and client basis out of the estate of the bankrupt upon taxation thereof.

YOU, Robert Nothof, being a director of the bankrupt corporation named herein, are required, pursuant to Section 159 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, to attend at the office of the Official Receiver at 451 Talbot Street, 3rd Floor, London, Ontario N6A 5C9 on \_\_\_\_\_ day, the \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2012, at the hour of \_\_\_\_\_ o'clock in the \_\_\_ noon, there to answer such questions with respect to the conduct of the bankrupt corporation, the causes of its bankruptcy and the disposition of its property as may be put by the Official Receiver, and take notice that if you fail to present yourself for examination, the Court may by warrant cause you to be apprehended and brought up for examination and may order you to be imprisoned for a term not exceeding three years.
