RE: Receivership of TDCI Bracebridge Inc.

We are writing further to the receipt of materials from the Applicants and Figueira and wanted to provide clarification regarding some of the points raised therein.

Ms. Kason states in Paragraph 3 of her affidavit that the movement of goods from the lockers owned by Premiere to a large room (the centre bay of the building) caused a delay in the Receiver paying proceeds from the Auction to Premiere. Mrs. Adshade, on behalf of Premiere, was paid \$4,089.42 from the sale of goods stored in the lockers as set out in the attached consignment summary. The consignment summary includes the details of the sales, and a copy of the cheque to Mrs. Adshade.

Some of the goods sold are claimed by Figueira and Tarback as personal items. Notwithstanding that they were removed from the lockers and sold from the centre bay of the TDCI building, they were recorded as locker content sales and the funds paid directly to Premiere by the auctioneer. We note that in his affidavit Mr. Figueira references some of the lockers in the consignment summary.

We do confirm that, prior to the Auction, Carol Tarback did attend on the TDCI premises and was permitted to remove a number of articles with no material value to allow her to provide for herself and her children subsequent to her separation from Figueira.

Subject to the foregoing we have no further comments on the materials filed by the Applicants or Mr. Figueira.
