**Re: Atlantica Diversified Transportation Services Inc.**

On December 7, 2017, the Nova Scotia Supreme Court granted a CCAA Initial Order, creating a stay of proceedings in favor of Atlantica and appointing BDO Canada as Monitor. A full copy of the Initial Order can be viewed on the Monitor's website at <http://extranets.bdo.ca/adts/index.cfm>.

The Court has scheduled December 22, 2017, at 9:30 a.m., at the Law Courts in Halifax for the hearing of any extension or other motions and has directed:

1. The Applicant is to advise by filing a motion on or before December 13, 2017, if it wishes to have any matters heard on December 22<sup>nd</sup> other than the request for an extension. If so, any affidavits and a draft order in support of such other motion(s) are to be filed by the Applicant on or before December 15, 2017.
2. The Monitor is to file any materials on the extension of the Initial Order ("the Extension Hearing") on or before December 18, 2017.
3. The Applicant is to file any materials on the Extension Hearing on or before December 19, 2017.
4. Any reply materials from creditors on any motion other than the extension hearing are to be filed on or before December 20, 2017.
5. Any reply materials from creditors on the extension hearing are to be filed on or before December 21, 2017.
6. The court retains discretion over all filing dates and requirements.
