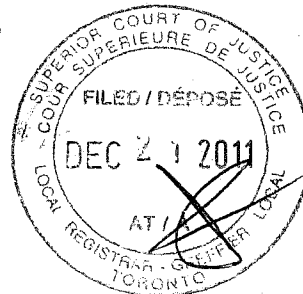
Counsel to BDO advises that there has been no adverse reaction to the Receiver's Report.
