THIS MATTER came before the Court on the motion of BDO Canada Limited, the court-appointed receiver (the "**Receiver**") and authorized foreign representative of Combat Sports Inc. ("**Combat CND**") and Combat Sports, Inc. ("**Combat USA**," and collectively with Combat CND, "**Combat**") in a proceeding (the "**Canadian Proceeding**") under Subsection 243(1) of Canada's *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c. B-3 (as amended) and

1 Section 101 of Ontario's *Courts of Justice Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. C.43 (as amended), pending  
2 before the Superior Court of Justice of Ontario (the "Canadian Court").

3 By its *Ex Parte Motion to Shorten Time for Response and Providing Form and Manner*  
4 *of Notice for Motion for Order Enforcing Approval and Vesting Order of the Canadian Court*  
5 (the "Shorten Notice Motion"), the Receiver requested entry of an order pursuant to Rule  
6 9006(c)(1) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Rule 9013(d)(3) Local Rules for  
7 the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Washington to permit  
8 consideration on shortened notice of the *Motion for Order Enforcing Approval and Vesting*  
9 *Order of the Canadian Court* (the "Enforcement Motion"). The Court has reviewed the  
10 motion, finds that good cause exists to grant the relief requested, and hereby grants the motion.

12 **NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

13 1. The Shorten Notice Motion is GRANTED.  
14 2. The hearing on the Enforcement Motion shall be held on May 3, 2013 at 9:30  
15 a.m. Responses or Objections to the Enforcement Motion shall be served no later than  
16 April 30, 2013 at 12:00 p.m.

18 3. The form of the Notice attached to the Shorten Notice Motion as Exhibit 2 is  
19 hereby approved.

21 4. Copies of the Notice and the Enforcement Motion shall be served by the  
22 Receiver by first-class postage prepaid upon all parties listed on the Matrix, all known creditors  
23 and all other parties against whom relief is sought (or their counsel), including any such parties  
24

1 (or counsel) that have addresses outside the United States, in accordance with Bankruptcy Rules  
2 7004(a) and (b) within 24 hours after entry of this order on the docket.

3 4. Service of the Notice and Enforcement Motion in accordance with this Order is  
4 hereby approved as adequate and sufficient notice and service on all interested parties of  
5 Enforcement Motion.
