**AFFIDAVIT OF CRAIG FRYZUK  
SWORN ON JULY 23<sup>RD</sup>, 2013**

I, Craig Fryzuk of Calgary, Alberta, SWEAR AND SAY THAT:

1. I am a Senior Vice President at BDO Canada Limited ("BDO"), and as such I have personal knowledge of the facts and matters herein deposed to except where stated to be based upon information and belief, and where so stated I verily believe the same to be true.
2. On June 29, 2007, pursuant to an Order of Mr. Justice V. Ouellette of the Court of Queen's Bench, BDO, formerly known as Browning Crocker Inc., was appointed Liquidator of Glenco Metals and Processing Inc. (the "Liquidation"), pursuant to sections 215, 218-229 and 239-242 of the *Business Corporations Act*, RSA 2000 c. B-9, as amended.
3. I am a licensed Trustee in Bankruptcy with over 14 years experience in the area of insolvency and restructuring, and have been handling the day to day administrative work in relation to the Liquidation.

4. With respect to BDO's accounts covering fees and disbursements incurred by BDO for the period of June 29, 2007 to May 27, 2012, as referenced in Exhibit 5 of the Liquidator's Second Report (the "Accounts"):
- (a) for the period of November 1, 2007 forward, the Accounts specifically outline the date, the description of work completed, the length of time taken to complete the work, the total invoiced amount for the work completed, and name of the individual who completed the work;
