ENDORSEMENT

- [1] This is a motion to approve the Fourth Report of the Proposal Trustee including the fees and disbursements of the Trustee and counsel and to extend the time for the companies to file proposals under s. 50.4(9) of the BIA to June 21, 2024. The current extension expires at midnight tomorrow which would result in deemed bankruptcies.
- [2] The Trustee also seeks approval for an Interim Distribution Order which would result in payment in full to Bank of Montreal and Glenn MacDonell (first and second priority secured creditors) as well as a partial payment to one of the numbered companies in the Grant Group.
- [3] The distribution order is subject to certain holdbacks explained in the motion record.

- [4] None of the affected parties put on notice oppose the orders. The Grant Group reserves the right to contest a certain setoff claim but it is not necessary to decide that question at the moment since there are insufficient funds to pay either the full claim or the reduced claim. The draft order contains language requested by counsel for Grant.
- [5] I am satisfied that the motion should be granted and I have signed both the Ancillary Order and the Interim Distribution Order.
