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I. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

- On July 18, 2024, the Supreme Court of British Columbia (the "Court") granted an Order (the "Receivership Order") appointing BDO Canada Limited, as receiver and manager (in such capacity, the "Receiver") of Vernon Recreational Products (VRP) Sales and Service Ltd. ("VRP") and 1390951 B.C. Ltd. ("139" and collectively, the "Companies").
- On September 17, 2024, the Court approved the sale of the assets of VRP to 1495213 B.C. LTD. On the same date, the Court approved the sale of the assets of 139 to 1494072 B.C. LTD.
- 3. On September 17, 2024, the Court approved an interim distribution to the Royal Bank of Canada in an amount up to \$8,000,000. On the same date the Cout also amended the Receivership Order to authorize the Receiver to assign the Companies into bankruptcy.
- 4. On October 1, 2024, the Receiver completed the sale of the 139 assets to 1494072 B.C. Ltd.
- 5. On October 3, 2024, the Receiver completed the sale of the VRP assets to 1495213 B.C. Ltd.
- On November 20, 2024, the Receiver assigned VRP and 139 into bankruptcy.
- 7. As of November 22, 2024, the first secured creditor, RBC has been repaid \$7,961,507. The remaining balance due to RBC is \$151,381 as at November 21, 2024 plus ongoing interest.

II. PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

8. This second report of the Receiver (this "**Second Report**") has been prepared to provide this Honourable Court with information with respect to the following:

- a) The activities of the Receiver since the Receiver's First Report to Court dated September 12, 2024;
- To request the Court's approval to payout the remaining balance owing to RBC of \$151,381 plus ongoing interest as at November 21, 2024; and,
- c) To outline the remaining activities to be undertaken by the Receiver up until the completion of the receivership.

III. SCOPE AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 9. In preparing this Report and in making the recommendations contained herein, the Receiver has relied upon information obtained from discussions with the principals, former employees of the Companies, and where appropriate, the Companies' books and records.
- 10. The Receiver has not audited, reviewed or otherwise attempted to verify the accuracy or completeness of such information and, accordingly, the Receiver expresses no opinion or other assurance in respect of such information as reflected in this Report.
- 11. All references to dollars are in Canadian currency unless otherwise noted.

IV. THE ACTIVITIES OF THE RECEIVER

- 12. Since the date of the Receiver's First Report to Court dated September 12, 2024, the Receiver has:
 - a) Completed the sale of the VRP assets to 1495213 B.C. Ltd.;
 - b) Completed the sale of the 139 assets to 1494072 B.C. Ltd.;
 - Liaised with Chase Payments and Elavon with respect to credit card merchant deposits held by the respective parties for sales made by credit card; and,

- d) Assigned both Companies into bankruptcy.
- 13. Attached as **Appendix A** is a copy of the filed Receiver's Certificate with respect to the completion of the sale of the assets to 1494072 B.C. Ltd.
- 14. Attached as **Appendix B** is a copy of the filed Receiver's Certificate with respect to the completion of the sale of the assets to 1495213 B.C. Ltd.
- 15. The Receiver needs to complete the following tasks prior to the completion of the receivership:
 - a) Payout the final amount owing to RBC of \$151,381, plus accrued interest to the date of the payout;
 - Securing the funds currently held by payment processors, Chase Merchant Services and Elavon Canada Company; and,
 - c) Applying for the discharge of the Receiver.
- 16. The Receiver requests the Court approve the payment of \$151,381, plus accrued interest to satisfy RBC's debt in full.

V. STATEMENT OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS

17. The Receiver is currently holding approximately \$958,000 between VRP and 139. A summary of the consolidated Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 18, 2024 to December 6, 2024 is summarized on the following page.

- 18. The Receiver estimates priority creditors for payroll source deductions and Wage Earner Protection Program ("WEPP") claims to be approximately \$127,000. These claims will rank in priority to the claim of RBC.
- 19. Attached as **Appendix C** is a copy of the Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 18, 2024 to December 6, 2024 of 139.

- 20. Attached as **Appendix D** is a copy of the Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 18, 2024 to December 6, 2024 of VRP.
- 21. The Receiver anticipates that there will be full payment to the first secured creditor, RBC, and therefore will be a recovery to other creditors who rank behind RBC.

VI. CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

Conclusion

- 22. The Receiver anticipates that there will be full payment to the first secured creditor, RBC. There are no other secured creditor claims.
- 23. The Receiver has completed the sale of the VRP and 139 Assets.
- 24. The Receiver has assigned the Companies into bankruptcy.

Recommendation

25. The Receiver recommends that the Court approve the final distribution to RBC of approximately \$151,381, plus accrued interest.
