ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:

The Receiver brings this motion for approval of (i) its thirteen reports; (ii) its fees and disbursements and those of its counsel; (iii) its statement of receipts and disbursements; (iv) a distribution payment to CIBC; and (v) administrative steps to be taken in connection with the Receiver's collection plan.

The motion is unopposed.

The relief sought is well explained in the Receiver's Thirteenth Report and is satisfactory to me. I directed the Receiver's counsel to add the standard language re approval of the Receiver's reports to the form of Distribution and Approval Order and to delete the previous paragraph 18 from that order. The Receiver can return to court for approval of future distributions to CIBC. Those changes have now been made.

I have signed the Distribution and Approval Order and the Order re Administration of the Receiver's Collection Plan and have attached them to this endorsement. These orders are effective from today's date and are enforceable without the need for entry and filing.
