TAKE NOTICE that an application will be made before the presiding Judge in Chambers at the Court House in the City of Yellowknife, Northwest Territories, on Friday the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. or so soon thereafter as counsel can be heard on behalf of BDO Canada Limited (the "Receiver"), in its capacity as Receiver and Manager of the assets, undertakings and properties of the Defendant Taiga Sports Fishing Ltd. o/a Blachford Lake Lodge ("Taiga") for the following relief:

- 1. A sealing order in substantially the form attached hereto as Schedule "B" (the "Sealing Order"), sealing the Confidential Supplement to the Receiver's Second Report (the "Confidential Supplement" and the "Second Report" respectively) on the Court file until the earlier of:
  - a. The Receiver's Certificate has been filed in relation to the proposed sale transaction; or
  - b. Further Order of the Court.
- 2. Such further and other relief as Counsel may request and this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Receiver intends to rely upon

the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, RSC 1985, c. B-3; Sierra Club of Canada v. Canada

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this

application is based are as follows:

1. The Confidential Supplement contains and discusses matters of a highly sensitive

commercial nature, and their publication could result in serious commercial damage

to Taiga's estate and could prejudice any future sales process, in the event that the

proposed sale transaction does not close, to the detriment of Taiga's stakeholders.

2. The Sealing Order is the least restrictive and prejudicial alternative to prevent the

dissemination of commercially sensitive information about the sales process, the

proposed sale transaction, Taiga's property and the respective stakeholders.

3. It is fair and just in the circumstances to restrict public access to the Confidential

Supplement.

4. Such further and other grounds as may be disclosed at the hearing of this

application.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that in support of the application will

be read the Second Report, which will be filed and served before the hearing of this matter;

the Affidavit of Kevin Meyler, sworn October 27, 2023; the Receivership Order,
