I, Bhaskar Kakkar, of the City of Calgary, in the Province of Alberta, MAKE OATH AND SAY THAT:

1. I am a Senior Manager in the Commercial Risk Advisory and Management group of ATB Financial ("**ATB**"), the Plaintiff in these proceedings, and as such have knowledge of the facts and matters hereinafter deposed to, except where stated to be based upon information and belief and where so stated I do verily believe the same to be true. I am authorized to make this Affidavit on behalf of ATB.
2. I make this affidavit in support of an application to extend the appointment of BDO Canada Limited ("**BDO**") as interim receiver ("**Interim Receiver**") of the assets, properties, and undertakings of Regent Aircraft Services Inc. ("**Regent**").
3. As set forth in my Affidavit sworn November 12, 2025, ATB is a secured creditor of Regent, and Regent is in default of its obligations to ATB.
4. ATB continues to assess options concerning Regent in light of Regent's defaults of its obligations to ATB, and requires additional time to make these assessments.

5. ATB remains concerned that the value of ATB's collateral may be compromised if not preserved by the Interim Receiver at this time.
6. I verily believe that the continued appointment of an interim receiver is necessary for the protection of ATB's interests and is further just and convenient in the circumstances.
7. ATB is supportive of the extension of the outside date for termination of the Interim Receiver until February 2, 2026.
8. ATB is supportive of the use of Regent's funds to pay for expenses related to the interim receivership and the increases in the Interim Receiver's Charge and borrowing charge sought by the Interim Receiver.
