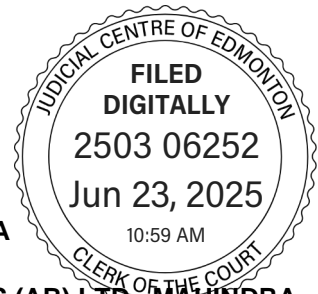

Remedy claimed or sought:

1. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the first report (the "**First Report**") dated June 23, 2025 of BDO Canada Limited ("**BDO**"), in its capacity as the Court-appointed receiver (the "**Receiver**") of Mahindra Investments (AB) Ltd. ("**Investments**"), Mahindra Jewellers (AB) Ltd., Surrey Gold Jewellers (AB) Ltd. and Bluewater (786) Contractors Ltd. (collectively, the "**Debtors**").

2. An abridgement of the time for service of this Application and materials in support thereof, and an Order declaring service of same to be good and sufficient.
3. An Order substantially in the form attached hereto as **Schedule "A"**:
 - a. approving the actions of BDO in its capacity as Interim Receiver, as set out in:
 - i. the Pre-Filing Report of the Proposed Interim Receiver dated March 26, 2025;
 - ii. the Interim Receiver's First Report dated April 16, 2025; and
 - iii. the First Report;
 - b. approving the Interim Receiver's Statement of Receipts and Disbursements as set out in the First Report;
 - c. approving the passing of the accounts for the fees and disbursements of BDO in its capacity as Interim Receiver, and those of its independent legal counsel, Dentons Canada LLP (the "**IR Accounts**"), as set out in the Fee Affidavit of Breanne Scott sworn June 23, 2025;
4. An Order substantially in the form attached hereto as **Schedule "B"**, granting the following relief, among other things:
 - a. approving activities of BDO in its capacity as Receiver as set out in the First Report;
 - b. approving the steps taken by the Receiver to negotiate and enter into the Sale Agreement (defined below), absent the Receiver conducting a sales process in the receivership;
 - c. vesting of the Assets to the Purchaser (defined below) free and clear of all claims, pursuant to the terms of the Purchase and Sale Agreement (defined below), and approving the Transaction (defined below);
 - d. authorizing the Receiver to conclude the Transaction and to take all such steps and execute all such documents as may reasonably be necessary to complete the transactions contemplated therein; and
 - e. declaring that, upon closing of the Transaction all of the Investments' right, title and interest, in and to the Assets shall, without further instrument or transfer or assignment, vest in the Purchaser free and clear of and from any and all claims, security interest, assignments, actions, levies, taxes, judgments, writs of execution, trusts or deemed trusts (whether contractual, statutory or otherwise), options, agreements, disputes, debts, easements, covenants, caveats, encumbrances or other rights, limitations or restrictions of any nature whatsoever including, without limitation, any rights or interest of any creditors of Investments.
5. An Order substantially in the form attached hereto as **Schedule "C"** sealing the Confidential Supplement to the First Report (the "**Confidential Supplement**") until all of the Assets are sold or such further order of this Court.

6. Such further and other relief as may be sought and this Honourable Court deems just and appropriate.

Grounds for making this application:

Interim Receivership

7. BDO was appointed as the Interim Receiver over all of the Debtors' jewellery and other inventory, accounts, money and instruments and records, pursuant to an Order granted by Justice C. Simard in this action on April 3, 2025 (the "**Interim Receivership Order**").
8. BDO took steps to preserve the assets and records of the Debtors subject to the Interim Receivership Order, as set out in the Interim Receiver's First Report and the First Report.
9. BDO believes that the IR Accounts are reasonable, taking into consideration the services that were provided, and seeks approval and a passing of these accounts in accordance with the terms of the Interim Receivership Order.

Sale Approval

10. BDO was appointed as the Receiver of all of the current and future assets, undertakings, and properties of every nature and kind whatsoever, and where situate, including all proceeds thereof of the Debtors pursuant to an Order granted by Justice C. Simard in this action on April 25, 2025.
11. Investments is the registered owner of two adjoining commercial condominium units located in Calgary, Alberta (the "**Assets**")
12. An offer to purchase the Assets (the "**Purchase and Sale Agreement**") was presented to the Receiver from 2670827 Alberta Inc. (the "**Purchaser**") (being, the "**Transaction**").
13. The Receiver is recommending acceptance of the Purchase and Sale Agreement and approval of the Transaction as being in the best interest of the creditors of the Debtors.
14. The Plaintiff in these proceedings, the primary secured creditor of the Debtor, is supportive of the Transaction.
15. The Confidential Supplement contain confidential information of a commercial nature which, if disclosed to third parties before the Assets are sold, could materially jeopardize the value that the Receiver is able to obtain from a sale of the Assets, and it is essential that this Honourable Court be made aware of this information in furtherance of its task to determine whether to approve, ratify, and accept the Purchase and Sale Agreement and authorize the Receiver to conclude the Transaction.
16. It is appropriate that this Honourable Court seal the Confidential Supplement on the Court record until all of the Assets are sold or such further order of this Honourable Court.
17. The First Report set out the activities of the Receiver and sets out the Receiver's manner of dealing with the Receivership. The Receiver seeks the approval of the Court for its activities set out in the First Report.

18. Such further and other grounds as counsel for the Receiver may advise.

UPON THE APPLICATION by BDO Canada Limited, in its capacity as Court-appointed Receiver (the "**Receiver**") of Mahindra Investments (AB) Ltd. (the "**Debtor**") for an order approving the sale transaction (the "**Transaction**") contemplated by an agreement of purchase and sale (the "**Sale Agreement**") between the Receiver and 2670827 Alberta Inc. (the "**Purchaser**") dated June 18, 2025 and appended to the Confidential Supplement (the "**Confidential Supplement**") to the First Report of the Receiver (the "**First Report**"), and vesting in the Purchaser (or its nominee) the Debtor's right, title and interest in and to the lands described in the Sale Agreement (the "**Lands**"); **AND UPON HAVING READ** the First Report, the Confidential Supplement and the Affidavit of Service; **AND UPON HEARING** the submissions of counsel for the Receiver;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

SERVICE

1. Service of notice of this application and supporting materials is hereby declared to be good and sufficient, no other person is required to have been served with notice of this application and time for service of this application is abridged to that actually given.

ACTIVITIES OF THE RECEIVER

2. The First Report and the Confidential Supplement are hereby accepted and approved.
3. The activities of the Receiver and its agents to date as detailed in the First Report and the Confidential Supplement be and are hereby approved.

APPROVAL OF TRANSACTION

4. The Transaction is hereby approved and execution of the Sale Agreement by the Receiver is hereby authorized and approved, with such minor amendments as the Receiver may deem necessary. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to take such additional steps and execute such additional documents as may be necessary or desirable i) for completion of the Transaction and conveyance of the Lands to the Purchaser (or its nominee), and ii) to assign any of the Leases (as defined in the Sale Agreement) to the Purchaser in accordance with the terms of the Sale Agreement.

VESTING OF PROPERTY

5. Upon delivery of a Receiver's certificate to the Purchaser (or its nominee) substantially in the form set out in **Schedule "A"** hereto (the "**Receiver's Closing Certificate**"), all of the Debtor's right, title and interest in and to the Lands listed in **Schedule "B"** hereto, shall vest absolutely in the name of the Purchaser (or its nominee), free and clear of and from any and all caveats, security interests, hypothecs, pledges, mortgages, liens, trusts or deemed trusts, reservations of ownership, royalties, options, rights of pre-emption, privileges, interests, assignments, actions, judgements, executions, levies, taxes, writs of enforcement, charges, or other claims, whether contractual, statutory, financial, monetary or otherwise, whether or not they have attached or been perfected, registered or filed and whether secured, unsecured or otherwise (collectively, "**Claims**") including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- (a) any encumbrances or charges created by the Receivership Order;

- (b) any charges, security interests or claims evidenced by registrations pursuant to the *Personal Property Security Act* (Alberta) or any other personal property registry system;
- (c) any liens or claims of lien under the *Builders' Lien Act* (Alberta), or any successor legislation; and
- (d) those Claims listed in Schedule "C" hereto (all of which are collectively referred to as the "**Encumbrances**", which term shall not include the permitted encumbrances, caveats, interests, easements, and restrictive covenants listed in Schedule "D" (collectively, "**Permitted Encumbrances**"))

and for greater certainty, this Court orders that all Claims including Encumbrances other than Permitted Encumbrances, affecting or relating to the Lands are hereby expunged, discharged and terminated as against the Lands.

6. Upon delivery of the Receiver's Closing Certificate, and upon filing of a certified copy of this Order, together with any applicable registration fees, all governmental authorities including those referred to below in this paragraph (collectively, "**Governmental Authorities**") are hereby authorized, requested and directed to accept delivery of such Receiver's Closing Certificate and certified copy of this Order as though they were originals and to register such transfers, interest authorizations, discharges and discharge statements of conveyance as may be required to convey to the Purchaser or its nominee clear title to the Lands subject only to Permitted Encumbrances. Without limiting the foregoing:

- (a) the Registrar of Land Titles ("**Land Titles Registrar**") for the Lands shall and is hereby authorized, requested and directed to forthwith:
 - (i) cancel existing Certificates of Title for the Lands legally described as:
 - Condominium Plan 2010546
Unit 47
and 107 undivided one ten thousandth shares in the common property
Excepting thereout all mines and minerals
 - Condominium Plan 2010546
Unit 48
and 111 undivided one ten thousandth shares in the common property
Excepting thereout all mines and minerals

(the "**Lands**")
 - (ii) issue a new Certificate of Title for the Lands in the name of the Purchaser (or its nominee);

- (iii) transfer to the New Certificate of Title the existing instruments listed in Schedule “D”, to this Order, and to issue and register against the New Certificate of Title such new caveats, utility rights of ways, easements or other instruments as are listed in Schedule “D”; and
 - (iv) discharge and expunge the Encumbrances listed in Schedule “C” to this Order and discharge and expunge any Claims including Encumbrances (but excluding Permitted Encumbrances) which may be registered after the date of the Sale Agreement (being June 30, 2025) against the existing Certificate of Title to the Lands.
- 7. In order to effect the transfers and discharges described above, this Court directs each of the Governmental Authorities to take such steps as are necessary to give effect to the terms of this Order and the Sale Agreement. Presentment of this Order and the Receiver’s Closing Certificate shall be the sole and sufficient authority for the Governmental Authorities to make and register transfers of title or interest and cancel and discharge registrations against any of the Lands of any Claims including Encumbrances but excluding Permitted Encumbrances.
- 8. No authorization, approval or other action by and no notice to or filing with any governmental authority or regulatory body exercising jurisdiction over the Lands is required for the due execution, delivery and performance by the Receiver of the Sale Agreement.
- 9. Upon delivery of the Receiver’s Closing Certificate together with a certified copy of this Order, this Order shall be immediately registered by the Land Titles Registrar notwithstanding the requirements of section 191(1) of the *Land Titles Act*, RSA 2000, c.L-7 and notwithstanding that the appeal period in respect of this Order has not elapsed. The Land Titles Registrar is hereby directed to accept all Affidavits of Corporate Signing Authority submitted by the Receiver in its capacity as Receiver of the Debtor and not in its personal capacity.
- 10. For the purposes of determining the nature and priority of Claims, net proceeds from sale of the Lands (to be held in an interest bearing trust account by the Receiver) shall stand in the place and stead of the Lands from and after delivery of the Receiver’s Closing Certificate and all Claims including Encumbrances (but excluding Permitted Encumbrances) shall not attach to, encumber or otherwise form a charge, security interest, lien, or other Claim against the Lands and may be asserted against the net proceeds from sale of the Lands with the same priority as they had with respect to the Lands immediately prior to the sale, as if the Lands had not been sold and remained in the possession or control of the person having that possession or control immediately prior to the sale. Unless otherwise ordered (whether before or after the date of this Order), the Receiver

shall not make any distributions to creditors of net proceeds from sale of the Lands without further order of this Court.

11. Except as expressly provided for in the Sale Agreement or by section 5 of the Alberta *Employment Standards Code*, the Purchaser (or its nominee) shall not, by completion of the Transaction, have liability of any kind whatsoever in respect of any Claims against the Debtor.
12. Upon completion of the Transaction, the Debtor and all persons who claim by, through or under the Debtor in respect of the Lands, and all persons or entities having any Claims of any kind whatsoever in respect of the Lands, save and except for persons entitled to the benefit of the Permitted Encumbrances, shall stand absolutely and forever barred, estopped and foreclosed from and permanently enjoined from pursuing, asserting or claiming any and all right, title, estate, interest, royalty, rental, equity of redemption or other Claim whatsoever in respect of or to the Lands, and to the extent that any such persons or entities remain in the possession or control of any of the Lands, or any artifacts, certificates, instruments or other indicia of title representing or evidencing any right, title, estate, or interest in and to the Lands, they shall forthwith deliver possession thereof to the Purchaser (or its nominee).
13. The Purchaser (or its nominee) shall be entitled to enter into and upon, hold and enjoy the Lands for its own use and benefit without any interference of or by the Debtor, or any person claiming by, through or against the Debtor.
14. Immediately upon closing of the Transaction, holders of Permitted Encumbrances shall have no claim whatsoever against the Receiver.
15. The Receiver is directed to file with the Court a copy of the Receiver's Closing Certificate forthwith after delivery thereof to the Purchaser (or its nominee).

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

16. Notwithstanding:
 - (a) the pendency of these proceedings and any declaration of insolvency made herein;
 - (b) the pendency of any applications for a bankruptcy order now or hereafter issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, R.S.C. 1985, c.B-3, as amended (the "BIA"), in respect of the Debtor, and any bankruptcy order issued pursuant to any such applications;
 - (c) any assignment in bankruptcy made in respect of the Debtor; and
 - (d) the provisions of any federal or provincial statute:

the vesting of the Lands in the Purchaser (or its nominee) pursuant to this Order shall be binding on any Receiver in bankruptcy that may be appointed in respect of the Debtor and shall not be void or voidable by creditors of the Debtor, nor shall it constitute nor be deemed to be a transfer at undervalue, settlement, fraudulent preference, assignment, fraudulent conveyance, or other reviewable transaction under the BIA or any other applicable federal or provincial legislation, nor shall it constitute oppressive or unfairly prejudicial conduct pursuant to any applicable federal or provincial legislation.

17. The Receiver, the Purchaser (or its nominee) and any other interested party, shall be at liberty to apply for further advice, assistance and direction as may be necessary in order to give full force and effect to the terms of this Order and to assist and aid the parties in closing the Transaction.
18. This Honourable Court hereby requests the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or in any of its provinces or territories or in any foreign jurisdiction, to act in aid of and to be complimentary to this Court in carrying out the terms of this Order, to give effect to this Order and to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such order and to provide such assistance to the Receiver, as an officer of the Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
19. Service of this Order shall be deemed good and sufficient by:
 - (a) Serving the same on:
 - (i) the persons listed on the service list created in these proceedings;
 - (ii) any other person served with notice of the application for this Order;
 - (iii) any other parties attending or represented at the application for this Order;
 - (iv) the Purchaser or the Purchaser's solicitors; andservice on any other person is hereby dispensed with.

- A. Pursuant to an Order of the Court dated June 30, 2025, the Honourable Justice Gill (the "**Order**") of the Court of King's Bench of Alberta, Judicial District of Edmonton (the "**Court**") approved the agreement of purchase and sale made as of June 18, 2025 (the "**Sale Agreement**") between BDO Canada Limited, in its capacity as Court-appointed Receiver (the "**Receiver**") of the current and future assets, undertakings, and properties of Mahindra Investments (AB) Ltd. (the "**Debtor**") and 2670827 Alberta Inc.
