Protocol for the First Meeting of Creditors

The following protocol will be adopted to facilitate a First Meeting of Creditors:

PRE-MEETING REQUIREMENTS – DEADLINE TO SUBMIT PROOFS OF CLAIM

- For the purposes of voting at the First Meeting of Creditors, the Trustee must receive the completed Proof of Claim **by 1:00 p.m. (Vancouver Time) on Monday, July 20, 2020;**
- For the purposes of voting at the First Meeting of Creditors, the Trustee must receive the completed Proxy **by 1:00 p.m. (Vancouver Time) on Monday, July 20, 2020;**
- Based on the email provided on the proof of claim the Trustee will provide the creditor with:
 - A copy of the Trustee's preliminary report on the administration of the estate of Conian Developments Inc.;
 - Status of claim – admitted, incomplete, or contested for voting purpose; and,
