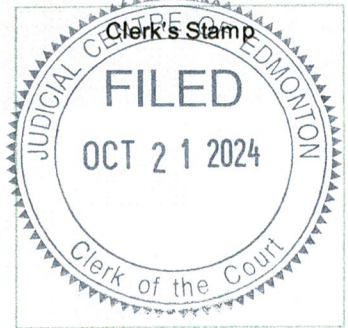

Remedy claimed or sought:

- Emergency Injunction order to Cease and Desist or Stay of Proceedings for order granted on October 17, 2024 in Calgary ,Alberta by Justice R.W. Armstrong for the stoppage of the Harm and Damage brought upon the DEFENDANT/APPLICANT. Compensation and Relief for all Harm and Damages that have been done against the DEFENDANT/ APPLICANT
2. Obtain the assistance of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police should we deem such assistance from the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in connection with the execution of this ORDER
 3. If deemable all parties involved with trespassing and Break and enter on private property shall be held accountable for their actions either at the scene or behind the scene.

4. This will supersede all other ORDERS
5. Relief for export shipment to Europe that has been delayed if not cancelled approx 300K that has caused Damage to the DEFENDANT/APPLICANT
6. Any other Relief this Court rules in favour for the DEFENDANT/APPLICANT
7. PLAINTIFF(S) /RESPONDENT to be liable for any damages to the Facility or any part of the cannabis production including but not limited to Live plants and equipment

Grounds for making this application:

8. Trespassing by all involved on private property that is posted Private Property No Trespassing
9. Federal Licensed Cannabis Facility with Authorized Access only.
10. No Warrant to Enter
11. Inconsistent Documentation RECEIVERSHIP ORDER
12. Upon DEMAND BDO Agent's did not produce Identification or their Agents, and forcefully entered Private Property and set off the alarms then proceeded to drill out locks.
13. Did not receive Notice for Hearing scheduled for October 17, 2024 and somehow moved to Calgary (I could not defend or state my case) unlawful.
14. DEFENDANT was escorted off their private property in Duress, without Contract, without Consent by R"C"M"P and threatened to be Arrested and to vacate their private property.
15. They are without Contract and No Consent
16. Upon Demand No proof of Authority or Jurisdiction was produced
17. DEFENDANT has made several attempts to settle this matter with ATB through Commerce.
18. Living Plants need immediate attention or will de cease
19. Crucial that the Facility has daily monitoring for plants and HVAC, and (Temperature and Humidity monitoring)
20. Point #3 on ORDER granted by Justice R.W. Armstrong on October 17,2024 clearly states,(For greater certainty, the Property shall specifically not include, and Receiver shall not take possession of nor be deemed to take possession of any of the Debtors assets, or any assets located upon or within the buildings located upon the lands ,for which any permit or license is issued or may be issued in accordance or connection with the following or similar legislation (collectively the Controlled Substances Legislation) which shall include any controlled substances subject to the Controlled Substances Legislation and the Receiver shall not be deemed to be in possession of any property within the meaning of the Controlled Substances Legislation (the Excluded Assets)
