On the application of [Receiver's Name] BDO Canada Limited, in its capacity as the Court-appointed [receiver/receiver and manager] receiver (the "Receiver") of the assets, undertakings and properties of [Debtor] (the "Property") of P.S. Electric Ltd. (the "Debtor") pursuant to the Order of this Court made * the Honourable Mr. Justice R.W. Elson made on October 13, 2020 (the "Receivership Order"); and upon hearing from counsel for * and upon reading the Notice of Application dated *December 9, 2020, the First Report of the Receiver dated December 8, 2020 (the "Receiver's First Report"), the Confidential Supplement to the First Report of the Receiver (the "Confidential Supplement") and a proposed Draft Order, all filed and the pleadings and proceedings having taken herein:

The Court Orde¹rs:

SERVICE

1. Service of the Notice of Application on behalf of the Receiver and the materials filed in support thereof (collectively, the "**Application Materials**") shall be and is hereby deemed to be good and valid and, further, shall be and is hereby abridged, such that service of such Application Materials is deemed to be timely and sufficient.

APPROVAL OF TRANSACTION AUCTION SALE

 The sale transaction (the "Transaction") contemplated by an agreement of purchase and sale (the "Sale Agreement") between the Receiver and [Name of Purchaser] The auction sale process (the "Purchaser") dated [Date] and appended to the Report of the Receiver dated

[Date] Auction Sale") contemplated in the proposal by McDougall Auctioneers Ltd. (the "**Report**"), for the sale to the Purchaser (or its nominee) ²of the Debtor's right, title and interest in and to Auctioneer") dated December 8, 2020 and accepted by the Receiver (the "Auction Contract") and appended to the Confidential Supplement, for the sale by the Auctioneer of the assets described in the Sale Agreement therein (the "Purchased Assets") is declared to be commercially reasonable and in the best interests of the Debtor and its creditors and other stakeholders³ and is hereby authorized and approved, with such minor amendments as the Receiver may deem necessary.

3. The Receiver shall be, and is hereby-, authorized and directed to sell all or substantially all of the Purchased Assets (as described in Schedule "B" to this Order) outside the ordinary course of business by public auction, upon substantially the same terms and conditions set out in the Auction Contract, and to take such additional steps and execute such additional documents as may be necessary or desirable (including any steps necessary or desirable to satisfy and/or comply with any applicable laws, regulations or orders of any courts, tribunals, regulatory bodies or administrative bodies in any jurisdiction in which the Purchased Assets may be located) for the completion of the Transaction-Auction Sale or for the conveyance of the Purchased Assets to the Purchaser (or its nominee), subject to such amendments as the Receiver and the Purchaser may agree upon, provided that any such amendments do not materially affect the Purchase Pricetheir respective purchasers.

VESTING OF PROPERTY

- 4. Upon the Receiver determining that the Proposed Auction Sale of any or all of the Purchased Assets has closed to its satisfaction and on terms substantially as approved by this Honourable Court pursuant to this Order, the Receiver shall deliver to the Purchaser purchaser of such Purchased Assets (or its nominee) a Receiver's certificate substantially in the form set out in Schedule "A" hereto (the "Receiver's Certificate").
- 5. The Receiver may rely on written notices from the Purchaser regarding fulfillment or, if applicable, waiver of conditions to closing of the Proposed Sale under the Sale Agreement communications from the Auctioneer regarding the closing of a sale of any or all of the Purchased Assets and shall have no liability with respect to the delivery of the Receiver's Certificate.
- 6. Upon delivery of the a Receiver's Certificate to the Auctioneer, all of the Debtor's right, title and interest in and to the Purchased Assets assets described in the Sale Agreement and listed on Schedule "B" hereto-that Receiver's Certificate shall, save and except for the encumbrances listed in Schedule "C" hereto (the "Permitted Encumbrances") "Permitted Encumbrances" set out in that Receiver's Certificate (or its nominee), free and clear of and from any and all security interests (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), hypothecs, interests, mortgages, trusts or deemed trusts (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), liens, judgments, enforcement charges, levies, charges, or other financial or monetary claims (collectively, "Encumbrances") and all rights of others, whether or not they have attached or

been perfected, registered or filed and whether secured, unsecured or otherwise (collectively, the "**Claims**")⁴ including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- (a) any encumbrances or charges created by the Receivership Order;
- (b) all charges, security interests or claims evidenced by registrations pursuant to *The Personal Property Security Act, 1993* SS 1993, c P-6.2, or any other personal property registry system; and
- (c) those Encumbrances listed in **Schedule** "**DC**" hereto;

and, for greater certainty, this Court orders that all of the Encumbrances (save and except for the Permitted Encumbrances) affecting or relating to the Purchased Assets <u>named in any</u> <u>Receiver's Certificate shall be, and</u> are hereby-, expunged and discharged as against the Purchased Assets <u>at the time of the delivery of the Receiver's Certificate</u>.

- 7. Upon delivery of the Receiver's Certificate to the <u>PurchaserAuctioneer</u>, the Receiver shall be and is hereby authorized to effect such discharges or revisions in the Saskatchewan Personal Property Registry as may be reasonably required to conclude <u>the Transaction.a transaction of</u> <u>purchase and sale.</u>
- 8. [Intentionally deleted.]
- 8. Pursuant to section 109 of *The Land Titles Act, 2000,* SS 2000, c L-5.1 and section 12 of *The Queen's Bench Act, 1998,* SS 1998, c Q-1.01 the Saskatchewan Registrar of Titles shall be and is hereby directed:

(a) to accept an application (the "Land Titles Application") to surrender the existing title to the real property legally described as:

and to set up a new title to such Real Property in the name of the Purchaser (or its nominee) as owner free and clear of any and all Encumbrances, save and except for the Permitted Encumbrances as set out in Schedule "C"; and

(b) for greater certainty, to discharge all interests described in Schedule "D" hereto.⁵

⁵-Consideration must be given as to whether it is appropriate, at law, for the Order to require that any particular interest be vested off title.

For instance, property tax liens require special consideration as a result of section 12 of *The Tax Enforcement Act*, RSS 1978, c T-2 ("**TEA**"). In most cases, property tax liens will be listed as a Permitted Encumbrance and paid from the net sale proceeds. If an applicant seeks to have a property tax lien included in Schedule "D" for discharge, consider (a) whether that

⁴-The "Claims" referenced here may, in some cases, include ownership claims, where ownership is disputed and the dispute is brought to the attention of the Court. Such ownership claims would, in that case, still continue as against the net proceeds from the sale of the claimed asset. Similarly, other rights, titles or interests could also be vested out, if the Court is advised what rights are being affected, and the appropriate persons are served.

- 9. Any and all registration charges and fees payable in regard to the Land Titles Application shall be to the account of the Purchaser.⁶
- 10. For the purposes of determining the nature and priority of the Encumbrances:
- 10. the net proceeds⁷-All net sale proceeds derived from the sale of (a) the any Purchased Assets (the "Net Sale Proceeds") shall stand in the place and stead of the respective Purchased Assets; and from which they are derived.
- (b)from 10A. From and after the delivery of the a Receiver's Certificate to the Purchaser, all Encumbrances and all rights of others shall attach to the Net Sale Proceeds from the sale of the Purchased Assets in question with the same priority as they had with respect to the such Purchased Assets immediately prior to the sale,⁸ as if the those Purchased Assets had not been sold and remained in the possession or control of the person having that possession or control immediately prior to closing of the Transactiontransaction.
- 11. <u>The No Purchaser (and its nor the nominee, if of any Purchaser) shall, by virtue of the completion of the Transaction, have no a transaction of purchase and sale pursuant to this Order, have any liability of any kind whatsoever in respect of any Claims against the Debtor.</u>
- 12. The Debtor and all persons who claim by, through or under the Debtor in respect of the Purchased Assets, save and except for the persons entitled to the benefit of the Permitted Encumbrances, shall stand absolutely barred and foreclosed from all estate, right, title, interest, royalty, rental and equity of redemption of the Purchased Assets and, to the extent that any such person remains in possession or control of any of the Purchased Assets, they shall forthwith deliver possession thereof to the Purchaser purchaser of such assets (or its nominee).
- 13. <u>The Purchaser A purchaser (or its nominee) shall be entitled to enter into and upon, hold and enjoy the Purchased Assets for its own use and benefit without any interference of or by the Debtor, or any person claiming by or through or against the Debtor.</u>

discharge needs to take a form of a direction to the municipal "treasurer" rather than to the Registrar of Titles; or (b) in national receiverships pursuant to section 243 of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, RSC 1985, c B-3, whether the Court has the jurisdiction to order the discharge notwithstanding section 12 of the TEA, by invoking the doctrine of federal paramountcy.

As another example, it will generally not be appropriate for a Sale Approval and Vesting Order to vest off interests which are registered subsequent to the granting of the Order. If there is a concern regarding registrations subsequent to the Order in a particular case, the procedure for having the Court deal with such interests will need to be considered.

- 14. Immediately after the closing of the Transactionany transaction of purchase and sale pursuant to this Order, the holders of the Permitted Encumbrances shall have no claim whatsoever against the Receiver or the Debtor.
- 15. Forthwith after the delivery of the a Receiver's Certificate to the Purchaser (or its nominee)Auctioneer, the Receiver shall file a copy of the Receiver's Certificate with the Court, and shall serve a copy of the Receiver's Certificate on the recipients listed in the Service List maintained with respect to these proceedings.
- 16. Pursuant to clause 7(3)(c) of the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act, SC 2000, c 5, the Debtor and the Receiver are hereby authorized and permitted to disclose and transfer to the Purchaser all human resources and payroll information in the Debtor's records pertaining to the Debtor's past and current employees. The Purchaser A purchaser receiving such information shall maintain and protect the privacy of such information and shall be entitled to use the personal information provided to it in a manner which is in all material respects identical to the prior use of such information by the Debtor.
- 17. Notwithstanding:
 - a) the pendency of these proceedings;
 - b) any applications for a bankruptcy order now or hereafter issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) in respect of the Debtor and any bankruptcy order issued pursuant to such applications;
 - c) any assignment in bankruptcy made in respect of the Debtor; and
 - d) the provisions of any federal statute, provincial statute or any other law or rule of equity,

the vesting of any of the Purchased Assets in the Purchaser a purchaser (or its nominee) pursuant to this Order and the obligations of the Debtor under the Sale AgreementReceiver pursuant to the Auction Contract, shall be binding on any trustee in bankruptcy that may be appointed in respect of the Debtor and shall not be void or voidable by creditors of the Debtor, nor shall it constitute nor be deemed to be a settlement, fraudulent preference, assignment, fraudulent conveyance, transfer at undervalue, or other reviewable transaction under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, RSC 1985, c B-3 or any other applicable federal or provincial legislation, nor shall it constitute oppressive or unfairly prejudicial conduct pursuant to any applicable federal or provincial legislation.

18. The Transaction <u>Any transaction of purchase and sale pursuant to this Order</u> is exempt from any requirement under any applicable federal or provincial law to obtain shareholder approval and is exempt from the application of any bulk sales legislation in any Canadian province or territory.

MISCELLANEOUS MATTERS

- 19. The Receiver, the Purchaser (or its nominee) any purchaser of Purchased Assets hereunder, and any other interested party, shall be at liberty to apply for further advice, assistance and directions as may be necessary in order to give full force and effect to the terms of this Order and to assist and aid the parties in closing the Transaction, including, without limitation, an application to the Court to deal with interests which are registered against title to the Real Property after the time of the granting of this Orderany transaction of purchase and sale.
- 20. This Court hereby requests the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or in the United States to give effect to this

Order and to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders as to provide such assistance to the Receiver, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.

- 21. Service of this Order on any party not attending this application is hereby dispensed with. Parties attending this application shall be served in accordance with the Electronic Case Information and Service Protocol adopted in the Receivership Order.⁹
- 22. All activities, actions and proposed courses of action of the Receiver (collectively, the "Actions of the Receiver") to date in relation to the discharge of its duties and mandate as Receiver pursuant to the Orders of this Honourable Court in these proceedings (collectively, the "Receiver's Mandate"), as such Actions of the Receiver are more particularly described in the First Report and the Confidential Supplement, shall be and are hereby approved and confirmed.
- 23. The Confidential Supplement, including all exhibits and appendices thereto, shall be kept sealed and confidential, and shall not form part of the public record but shall be kept separate and apart from the other contents of the Court file in respect of this matter in a sealed envelope which sets out the style of cause of these proceedings and a statement that the contents thereof are subject to a Sealing Order, and shall not be opened except by a Judge of the Saskatchewan Court of Queen's Bench or by further Order of the Court.
