4. The Receiver’s Interim Statement of Receipts and Disbursements attached as Appendix C to the Second Report is hereby approved.
5. The Receiver’s accounts for fees and disbursements, including the legal costs of its counsel, as set out at paragraph 44 of the Second Report is hereby approved.


