**NAME OF JUSTICE WHO GRANTED THIS ORDER: THE HONOURABLE JUSTICE G.S. DUNLOP**

**UPON THE APPLICATION FOR BANKRUPTCY ORDER** filed by Yes Plan Auto Finance Inc. (“**Yes Plan**”), a creditor of Mahindra Jewellers (AB) Ltd. (the “**Debtor**”), in the Province of Alberta filed on December 8, 2025; **AND UPON READING** the Application and the Affidavit of Verification of Latha Thomas-Back, sworn December 5, 2025; **AND UPON** being satisfied that the Debtor, BDO, the Office of the Superintendent in Bankruptcy and all other interested and affected parties have been served with an unfiled notice of Originating Application; **AND UPON**

noting the consent of the proposed trustee, BDO Canada Limited (“**BDO**”), to be appointed as trustee of the bankrupt estate of the Debtor and being satisfied that it is a person qualified to act; **AND UPON** hearing from counsel for Yes Plan, counsel for BDO as receiver of the Debtor and any other interested party appearing at the application; **AND UPON** being satisfied that the following acts of bankruptcy have been committed by the Debtor within six months preceding the filing of the Application seeking this Order:

- a. the Debtor has failed to meet its liabilities generally as they became due; and
- b. on April 25, 2025, BDO was appointed as receiver of the property, assets and undertaking of the Debtor pursuant to a Receivership Order of the Honourable Justice Simard in Court of King’s Bench of Alberta File No. 2503-06252.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Leave to proceed with this Application is granted notwithstanding that the application for this Order was not signed by a Registrar in Bankruptcy prior to its filing.
2. The time for service of the Originating Application and supporting materials is abridged to that actually given, service is deemed good and sufficient notwithstanding that unfiled copies of the Originating Application and Affidavit of Verification were served, and this Application is properly returnable today.
3. Mahindra Jewellers (AB) Ltd. is adjudged bankrupt.
4. BDO be and is hereby appointed trustee of the estate of the Debtor without the requirement to give security under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.
