APPROVAL AND VESTING ORDER

THIS MOTION, made by BDO Canada Limited in its capacity as the Court-appointed receiver (the "Receiver"), without security, of all the assets, undertakings and properties (the "Property") of Mara Tech Aviation Fuels Ltd., Mara-Tech Aviation Services Ltd., Mara Tech Aviation Fuels (Thompson) Ltd., and Mara Tech Aviation Fuels (Sudbury) Ltd. (the "Debtors") for an order approving the sale transaction (the "Transaction") contemplated by an agreement of purchase and sale (the "Sale Agreement") between the Receiver and Executive Aviation Fuels Ltd. (the "Purchaser") dated November 4, 2016 and appended to the Confidential Supplement to the Second Report dated December 7, 2016 (the "Confidential Supplement Report"), and for an

Order vesting in the Purchaser the Debtor's right, title and interest in the "Purchased Assets" as described in the Sale Agreement, was heard this day at 59 Church Street, St. Catharines, Ontario.

ON READING the First Report of the Receiver dated November 14, 2016 (the "First Report"), the Second Report of the Receiver dated December 5, 2016 (the "Second Report"), the Confidential Supplement Report and the Notice of Motion herein and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Receiver, no one appearing for any other person on the service list, although properly served as appears from the affidavit of Sherine Burke sworn December 7, 2016, filed,

- 1. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that any requirement for service of the Notice of Motion, First Report, Second Report and Motion Record be and is hereby abridged; that the Motion is properly returnable today and that all parties requiring notice of this Motion have been duly served and that service on all parties is hereby validated and any further service is hereby dispensed with.
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the Transaction is hereby approved, and that the Sale Agreement is commercially reasonable and in the best interests of the Debtor and its stakeholders. The execution of the Sale Agreement by the Receiver is hereby authorized and approved, with such minor amendments as the Receiver may deem necessary. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to take such additional steps and execute such additional documents as may be necessary or desirable for the completion of the Transaction and for the conveyance of the Purchased Assets to the Purchaser.
- 3. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that upon the delivery of a Receiver's Certificate to the Purchaser substantially in the form attached as Schedule A hereto (the "Receiver's Certificate"), all of the Debtors' right, title and interest in and to the Purchased Assets shall vest absolutely in the Purchaser, save and except the Baggage Handling Equipment (as hereinafter defined) which shall vest absolutely in the Additional Purchaser (as hereinafter defined), free and clear of and from any and all security interests (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), hypothecs, mortgages, trusts or deemed trusts (whether contractual, statutory, or otherwise), liens, executions,

levies, charges, or other financial or monetary claims, whether or not they have attached or been perfected, registered or filed and whether secured, unsecured or otherwise (collectively, the "Claims") including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing: (i) any encumbrances or charges created by the Order of the Honourable Justice Lococo dated August 4, 2016; (ii) all charges, security interests or claims evidenced by registrations pursuant to the *Personal Property Security Act* (Ontario) or any other personal property registry system; (iii) those Claims listed on Schedule B hereto (all of which are collectively referred to as the "Encumbrances"); and (iii) for greater certainty, this Court orders that all of the Encumbrances affecting or relating to the Purchased Assets are hereby expunged and discharged as against the Purchased Assets.

- 4. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that Mara Tech Aviation Fuels Ltd. and Mara-Tech Aviation Services Ltd. are the sole tenants of those lands, premises and buildings that are described in leases and renewals thereof between Marandola Holdings Ltd. as tenant and Sault Ste. Marie Airport Development Corporation as landlord with respect to property or premises at the Sault Ste. Marie Airport.
- 5. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that any leases or renewals thereof in the name of Marandola Holdings Ltd. as tenant and Sault Ste. Marie Airport Development Corporation as landlord are null and void and have no force and effect.
- 6. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the Receiver is empowered and authorized, in conjunction with the completion of the Transaction to terminate:
 - (a) any lease agreements between Mara Tech and Sault Ste. Marie Airport Development Corporation, North Bay Jack Garland Airport Corporation, Sudbury Airport Community Development Corporation and Serco Aviation Services Inc. relative to the entitlement of Mara Tech to occupy or have possession of the premises at the subject airports,
 - (b) any agreements between Mara Tech and its customers including Porter Airlines Inc., Jazz Aviation LP, Bearskin Airlines and Sunwing Airlines Inc., and

- (c) any supply agreement between Mara Tech and World Fuels Services Canada, ULC.
- 7. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Receiver is also empowered and authorized to amend the Sale Agreement to (a) exclude from the Purchased Assets all and any of the assets of the Debtors located at the Windsor Airport; and (b) deliver and transfer to Executive Aviation Fuels (Sudbury) Ltd., (the "Additional Purchaser") an affiliate of the Purchaser, the baggage handling equipment located at the Sudbury operation, as more particularly set out in Schedule "D" titled "Baggage Handling Equipment".
- 8. THIS COURT ORDERS that immediately upon the Receiver delivering to the Debtors a duly executed copy of the Receiver's Certificate, the Debtors will deliver to the Purchaser, the Purchased Assets and particularly:
 - (a) The equipment that is located at the North Bay, Sudbury and Sault Ste. Marie airports including the equipment that is listed in Schedule "C" attached.
 - (b) Possession of the premises that the Debtors lease or occupy at the North Bay, Sudbury and Sault Ste. Marie airports.
- 9. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Receiver may deliver the Receiver's Certificate to the Debtors by email to John Marandola at jmarandola@maratech.org and to lawyer Luigi De Lisio at delisio@bellnet.ca and the same shall be deemed to have been validly and effectively given on the date of transmission if such date is a business day or is Saturday December 17th, 2016 and such transmission was made during the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to the recipient; otherwise it shall be deemed to have been validly and effectively given on the business day next following such date of transmission.
- 10. THIS COURT ORDERS that for the purposes of determining the nature and priority of Claims, the net proceeds from the sale of the Purchased Assets shall stand in the place and stead of the Purchased Assets, and that from and after the delivery of the Receiver's Certificate all Claims and Encumbrances shall attach to the net proceeds from the sale of the Purchased Assets with the same priority as they had with respect to

the Purchased Assets immediately prior to the sale, as if the Purchased Assets had not been sold and remained in the possession or control of the person having that possession or control immediately prior to the sale.

- 11. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DIRECTS the Receiver to file with the Court a copy of the Receiver's Certificate, forthwith after delivery thereof to the Purchaser.
- 12. THIS COURT ORDERS that, notwithstanding:
 - (a) the pendency of these proceedings;
 - (b) any applications for a bankruptcy order now or hereafter issued pursuant to the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) in respect of the Debtor and any bankruptcy order issued pursuant to any such applications; and
 - (c) any assignment in bankruptcy made in respect of the Debtor;

the vesting of the Purchased Assets in the Purchaser pursuant to this Order shall be binding on any trustee in bankruptcy that may be appointed in respect of the Debtor and shall not be void or voidable by creditors of the Debtor, nor shall it constitute nor be deemed to be a settlement, fraudulent preference, assignment, fraudulent conveyance, transfer at undervalue, or other reviewable transaction under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada) or any other applicable federal or provincial legislation, nor shall it constitute oppressive or unfairly prejudicial conduct pursuant to any applicable federal or provincial legislation.

- 13. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the Transaction is exempt from the application of the *Bulk Sales Act* (Ontario).
- 14. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the actions of the Receiver as set out in the First Report, Second Report and Confidential Supplement Report be and are hereby approved.

- 15. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the Appraisal Report dated August 26, 2016 of Canam Appraiz Inc. and referred to in the Confidential Supplement Report is hereby sealed until such further Order of the Court.
- 16. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that the Agreement of Purchase and Sale dated November 4, 2016 between the Receiver and Executive Aviation Fuels Ltd. is hereby sealed until such further Order of the Court.
- 17. THIS COURT HEREBY REQUESTS the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or in the United States to give effect to this Order and to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Receiver, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Receiver and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
