Please be advised that on June 11, 2026, 1823741 Alberta Ltd. (“**182**” or the “**Company**”) was assigned into bankruptcy by BDO Canada Limited (“**BDO**”), in its capacity as Receiver of the Company and as previously authorized by the Court of King’s Bench of Alberta, and BDO was appointed as licensed insolvency trustee (the “**Trustee**”) of the bankrupt estate.

Statement of Affairs

The Company’s Statement of Affairs (“**SofA**”) has been prepared by the Receiver based on the Company’s unaudited books and records as at the date of the receivership, together with certain assumptions as of that date and information obtained during the course of the receivership proceedings.

As noted in the SofA, asset realizations have been nominally estimated at \$1. The Company’s material assets were realized in the receivership, with proceeds distributed to the secured lender, and only nominal residual funds remain in the receivership estate. Any additional recoveries available for distribution to unsecured creditors will be contingent upon additional asset recoveries, if any, realized in the receivership or bankruptcy proceedings.

Proof of Claim

The proof of claim should be completed to only include amounts that were due to you by the Company prior to the initial receivership date of October 15, 2024, as the Receiver completed a post receivership claims process for claims after this date and during the receivership period.
