ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:

- [1] Case conference held today. The Receiver has funds to distribute but says there is a circular priority issue and cannot come up with a distribution waterfall at this point. Once it distributes the funds, it will seek a discharge.
- [2] I have directed counsel to discuss this priority issue and try to avoid a motion. The Receiver said it will be preparing a report by the end of next week, which will provide additional information that may assist in resolving this issue.
- [3] Counsel to confer. If a resolution is reached, the Receiver can arrange another case conference before any Commercial List judge for an unopposed order. If not, counsel shall arrange a scheduling appointment through the Commercial List office to set a date and timetable for the priority dispute to be argued.
